Specialty Medication

Specialty medications are generally prescribed for people with complex or ongoing medical conditions such as HIV, multiple sclerosis, hemophilia and rheumatoid arthritis. These high-cost medications also have one or more of the following characteristics:

- Injected or infused, but some may be taken by mouth
- Unique storage or shipment requirements
- Additional education and support required from a health care professional
- Typically not stocked at retail pharmacies

Prior Authorization and Prescription

Many specialty medications require an approved prior authorization before they can be dispensed. Prior authorizations for select specialty medications will be managed by Archimedes. As part of the prior authorization process, your provider must submit all necessary clinical information to Archimedes for clinical review. After reviewing the information provided in the prior authorization request, Archimedes will either approve or deny the request and notify you and your prescriber of this determination. If your prior authorization request is approved, your prescriber will need to submit a prescription to the correct specialty pharmacy for you to fill your medication.



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Frequently Asked Questions

What pharmacy can I use to fill my specialty medication?

Most specialty medications will need to be filled by the preferred pharmacy, **AcariaHealth Specialty Pharmacy**. AcariaHealth provides home delivery services for specialty drugs, timely refills when you need them, and 24/7 access to pharmacists and nurses. You may need to use a different pharmacy depending on medication access, and a small number of specialty medications are limited distribution drugs that may only be filled at a specific pharmacy. If you are taking a limited distribution drug, Archimedes will connect you to a pharmacy that can dispense your medication. HIV medications can be filled through AcariaHealth or a retail pharmacy in Archimedes' network. What ID card should I use when filling my specialty medication?

You will not receive a separate ID card for Archimedes. The specialty pharmacy will have all the information needed to process your specialty medication. If you are filling a limited distribution drug at another specialty pharmacy or an HIV medication at a retail pharmacy, Archimedes will provide the pharmacy with your benefit information.

How do I enroll in a copay assistance program?

Many specialty medications have copay assistance programs where a drug manufacturer pays for all or part of the drug's cost to make it more affordable. These programs offer significant savings. If you do not currently use a copay assistance program, Archimedes will help you enroll so you can take advantage of these savings.
