The Scholarship

The Kneeland Scholars program awards up to \$2,500 per year, per recipient, renewable for up to three additional years. That's a potential \$10,000 in scholarship money! To receive a renewal, the recipient must remain a full-time student with satisfactory academic achievement, his or her parent must remain a UR employee, and UR must continue to offer the scholarship.

Who Can Apply?

Applicants must:

- Be dependent children* age 26 or younger of a current, full-time UR employee worldwide who has been employed with the Company for at least one year** as of the application date
- Be high school seniors or graduates, or current postsecondary undergraduates seeking an undergrad degree/certification
- Be enrolled in or enrolling in full-time study at an eligible postsecondary institution including an accredited two- or four-year college, university, or vocational-technical school
- Have a minimum GPA of 2.5 on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent) at the time of application

How to Apply

Starting April 1st, apply at UnitedRentals.com/scholarships and follow the instructions on the website. The window to apply will close at 11:59 pm PST on May 1st.

Selection Process

International Scholarship & Tuition Services (ISTS) will select recipients based on a student's financial need, academic record, demonstrated leadership, involvement in school and community activities, work experience, statement of career and educational goals, and unusual personal or family circumstances. United Rentals will not play a part in the selection of recipients. If selected, your child would receive a notification sometime in late May or early June.***
